

SARAJEVO & MOSTAR

13.12. 2019 – 15.12.2019

DAY 1

PIRAN-PORTOROŽ-KOPER-SARAJEVO



Bus departure from the main station in Piran at 02:00, Portorož main station at 02:15 and Koper (Olly burger) at 02:40am.

We will visit the bridge where World War I. started, Gazi Husrev-beg mosque, beautiful National library, Emperor's mosque and the old town Baščaršija with its bazaar. Break for lunch and individual exploring. Next we will check into our hostel, settle in and after dark take a walk to the Christmas market and enjoy the magic of the holiday spirit. Optional: take a walk to the fortress to see the city lights from above. Time off for dinner. We meet in the hostel at 22:00, to warm up for our first party in Club Tresor.

Tip: *Try čevapčići with some pita bread, kajmak cheese and of course typical coffee with traditional desert baklava*

DAY 2

SARAJEVO-TITO'S BUNKER-MOSTAR

After breakfast and check-out, you will have some free time to explore Sarajevo on your own (maybe go shopping to the old town or enjoy one more round of čevapčići 😊)

Next, we will go to the former Yugoslavian president Tito's underground nuclear bunker that was a military secret until the end of the Bosnian war.



Our next stop will be Mostar with its famous bridge. We will take a walk to the city center and enjoy our dinner in one of the restaurants. Next stop will be our hostel, where we will get ready for our night out in The Pink Panther club.

DAY 3

MOSTAR-KRAVICE WATERFALLS-KOPER-PORTOROŽ-PIRAN

After breakfast we will leave our hostel and pay another visit to Mostar during the day.



Our next stop will be the gorgeous Kravice waterfalls, where we will take a stroll through the nature.
