









# SUMMER SCHOOL "3R for CULTURAL TOURISM"

»Remnants of the WWI – Research, Renovation and Rejuvenation of Cultural Tourism Sites«

2<sup>nd</sup> September 2013 – 18<sup>th</sup> September 2013 Komen, Slovenia

The summer school is an Erasmus Intensive Programme (IP) organized by four partner universities:

- University of Primorska, Koper, Slovenia,
- University of Klagenfurt, Austria,
- University of Rijeka, Faculty of Tourism and Hospitality Management in Opatija, Croatia,
- University of Trieste, Italy.

The coordinator of the project is the University of Primorska, which is cooperating closely with the Municipality of Komen where the IP will take place. Komen is situated in the Slovenian Karst region, which is due to its historical events during the 1<sup>st</sup> World War (Battles of Isonzo) a life monument.

The Summer School aims to train students in building their capacities in facing major issues in discovering and studying Karst landscapes and their natural and cultural heritage. It is designed for undergraduate and postgraduate students and professors from different teaching backgrounds from four different universities from four countries.



## The Goal

The summer school's goal is to research, renovate, and rejuvenate the remnants of the Battle of Isonzo and thus show the importance of common European history for EU integration, cooperation and sense of peace among nations, its citizens, connected through cultural heritage and tourism attraction.

### **The Course**

The summer school lasts 17 days and consists of various lecturers, workshops, study visits and sightseeing tours. It interdisciplinary combines the following areas/study fields: built environment (architecture, urban planning, landscape design, sustainable engineering), geography, history, anthropology, landscape ecology, sustainable tourism etc.

The participants will learn about the use of caverns, caves and other historical monuments in the past as well as the cartography proceedings needed for their description and inclusion in geodesic and other

registers. They will also prepare the reconstruction plan proposal and the plan for the future purpose and use of the remnants, including the marketing plan. Students will be awarded with ECTS.

### For whom it's intended

The summer school is intended for undergraduate and postgraduate students who are interested in the study fields covered by the programme. The language of the programme is English, therefore students have to be fluent in English (at least on B1 level).

Students will be selected on the basis of their area of studies, willingness and motivation to contribute to a comparative European learning experience. Preference will be given to undergraduate students in the final year of study and postgraduate students.

# Summer School Dates: 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2013 – 18<sup>th</sup> September 2013

Students have to participate in the IP for its entire duration.

#### Location

The summer school will be held in Komen in the Karst region of Slovenia.

The Komen Karst has been known for the traditional terrano and prosciutto ever since, however, it is also praised for its unspoiled nature full of bicycle trails, footpaths, and the very interesting and mysterious caves still to be explored.

#### Costs

There is no participation fee.

The travel costs as well as the costs of accommodation and meals (subsistence costs) are co-financed by the Erasmus program. The students will be refunded (upon receipt) for the travel costs from their home institution town to Koper. From Koper to Komen a bus transport will be organized (the meeting point on 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2013 at the University of Primorska, Titov trg 4 in the centre of Koper at 10.30). The health and accident insurance have to be covered by students.


